- Red Road healing approach knowledge by training, personal experience as used in Native American addiction treatment.
- Knowledge and understanding of Native American Culture and Traditions, Lakota, Nakota, and Dakota preferred but not required.
- Certification on Positive Indian Parenting Classes or willing to be certified.
- A flexible schedule.
- The ability to perform Cultural Native American Ceremonies.

Responsibilities:

- Leading recovery groups in accordance to the Native American Culture
- Maintaining confidentiality of all participants
- Communicating with group coordinator
- Keeping accurate records of attendance and group attendance.
- Needs to be CPR certify or willing to be train
